

The V Foundation for Cancer Research was founded by ESPN and legendary basketball coach Jim Valvano in 1993 with one goal in mind: to achieve Victory Over Cancer®.

Since its formation in 1993, the V Foundation has awarded nearly \$290 million in cancer research grants nationwide and has grown to become one of the premier supporters of cutting-edge cancer research. Due to generous donors, the Foundation has an endowment that covers administrative expenses meaning that every penny raised is invested in research to conquer cancer.

Jim Valvano, for whom the V Foundation is named, had a successful coaching career with multiple schools, most notably at North Carolina State University. While the head coach at NC State, his team won the 1983 NCAA Division I men's basketball title against improbable odds. Valvano is most remembered for his ecstatic celebration after winning the national championship game against the heavily favored

the national championship game against the heavily favored Houston Cougars.

Valvano is also remembered for an inspirational and memorable speech delivered at the 1993 ESPY Awards while terminally ill with cancer. Valvano implored the audience to laugh, think, and cry each day and announced the formation of The V Foundation for Cancer Research whose motto would be "Don't give up. Don't ever give up."





2022 LOCAL HONOREE Judy Matt

Dr. Judith A. Matt is President of the Spirit of Springfield, celebrating Springfield's biggest, best and brightest since 1989, and she is co-founder of Bright Nights at Forest Park.

Under her leadership, the Spirit of Springfield brings the community together in celebration with events that include World's Largest Pancake Breakfast, Star Spangled Springfield, Springfield's September 11th Ceremony, City of Bright Nights Ball, and Bright Nights at Forest Park, which has welcomed more than 6 million visitors since opening in 1995. One of her proudest moments was seeing the completion of Springfield's September 11th Monument.

She has raised several millions in corporate contributions and donated products and services. She has shared her talents to assist with MGM Springfield's opening procession and Red Sox Winter Weekend, Basketball

Hall of Fame Enshrinements, Dr. Seuss Museum opening, and many municipal events.



Prior to the Spirit of Springfield, Dr. Matt served as Commissioner of the Mayor's Office of Community Affairs.

work in combatting polio worldwide. However, the foundations mission extends to combating illiteracy, resolving conflict and economically empowering individuals around the world. A small action of a \$100 donation made by a Springfield Rotarian has the ripple effect of positivity to bring dignity and opportunity to our fellow global citizens."

When Jack is not participating in Rotary, he enjoys swinging a hammer at Greater Springfield Habitat for Humanity where he is a past Chair of their signature spring fund raiser "Men Can Cook." He was also deeply involved in the Young Professional Society of Springfield from 2008 to 2013.


